DESCRIPTION

A Respirator is a device that protects workers from inhaling harmful substances such as airborne vapors, gases, dusts, fogs, fumes, mists, smokes or sprays. This module provides awareness of respirator requirements, the types of respirators, and how they can be effectively and safely used. Follow-up training on the proper fitment of a respirator must be taken prior to utilizing a respirator.
