### PURCHASE WHEELCHAIRS

We help purchase custom-fit wheelchairs for individuals in need. A custom-fit wheelchair is their lifeline to a healthier life and more feasible independence.

### PURCHASE MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

We help purchase Durable Medical Equipment that is a necessity for everyday living. We help purchase home/car adaptations as well as equipment for at-home therapy.

## MEET A CLIENT ALEXIS EVANS

Hello, my name is Alexis Evans! I sustained a C1-C2 spinal cord injury from a motor vehicle accident on December 21, 2021. I was driving to work on the 91 Freeway in Anaheim when I came to a stop for traffic. The driver behind me failed to slow down, rear-ending me at full highway speed. The impact caused my skull to dislocate from my spine, known as an internal decapitation. The initial prognosis was grim, but I quickly began to show signs of improvement that were previously thought to be impossible by my doctors.

After about a year of rehabilitation, despite my continuing improvement, my insurance decided to stop paying for physical therapy. It was around this time that I found The Perfect Step. The Be Perfect Foundation then awarded me a scholarship to attend The Perfect Step. This financial assistance allowed me to regain an active lifestyle, returning to

therapy at The Perfect Step twice a week. Getting back into physical therapy and seeing myself continue to improve after having to take a break from therapy helped re-instill hope back into my life. I maintain hope for the future as my specialists help me to achieve my goals.

Coming into The Perfect Step, a couple of my major goals were to transition to a manual wheelchair and to stand unassisted. I'm proud to say that I have made significant improvements in both of these areas. I have successfully pushed myself into a manual wheelchair and am currently in the process of getting a manual chair of my own. I have also been working on my standing balance, seemingly improving every session, to the point where I was recently able to maintain my balance without any physical assistance from anyone or anything. With the support of the Be Perfect Foundation and The Perfect Step, I continue to work towards other goals like independently transferring and walking unassisted. I am confident that Be Perfect Step will ultimately help me achieve these goals as well.

It is difficult to put into words how grateful I am to Be Perfect and their donors for supporting me. Be Perfect's contribution has allowed me to receive amazing physical therapy and subsequently improve my quality of life. Today I can confidently say that I am feeling stronger both mentally and physically than before I started at The Perfect Step. These improvements were only possible thanks to the incredible generosity of the Be Perfect Foundation and donors. Because of Be Perfect, I am once again excited for what the future holds.


## OUR PROMISE

## MEET A CLIENT NASH GRIM

Meet Nash Grim, a remarkable individual whose journey took an unexpected turn on February 4, 2021, when he experienced a profound transformation due to a controversial incident. At his 6-month well check, Nash received the DTaP vaccine, triggering a hyperimmune response that led his own immune system to attack his spinal cord. This devastating chain of events left him paralyzed from the neck down, an outcome that defied his young age.

The Be Perfect Foundation stepped in to offer invaluable support to Nash and his family. Recognizing the unique challenges they faced, the foundation is providing a WonderFold Wagon tailored to Nash's specific needs. This adaptive wagon not only ensures Nash's safety but also accommodates his medical equipment, facilitating their on-the-go lifestyle.

The impact of this assistance is immeasurable for Nash's family. The burden of ensuring his safety and the transportation of his essential medical items will now be significantly eased. With the WonderFold Wagon, Nash's family gains the peace of mind that comes from knowing their precious child is secure, and they can efficiently carry everything required to care for him.

Nash's progress has been remarkable since his injury. The initial goals of regaining head control, enhancing arm and hand movement, and reducing reliance on his ventilator have been met with inspiring results. While challenges persist due to the effects of his injury, Nash has shown substantial improvements in head and trunk control, as well as some arm mobility. The foundation's support now extends to

Nash's continuing journey toward achieving complete trunk control, independent sitting, improved sensation, and speech development, despite the challenges posed by his tracheostomy.

The heartfelt gratitude Nash's family feels towards the Be Perfect Foundation is evident. They express deep appreciation for the scholarship that has eased the complexities of their medical journey. The foundation's contribution has lightened their load and made their lives more manageable, allowing them to focus on Nash's progress and well-being. The family acknowledges the extraordinary strength of the disabled community and the bonds formed with others who share similar experiences. The support received from organizations like the Be Perfect Foundation has transformed their daunting new reality into a more navigatable path, a testament to the power of compassion.
